So You Want to File a Writ Petition: Nuts and Bolts of Petition Preparation and What Happens Next

This training will explain how to file a writ petition, with content ranging from legal arguments necessary to demonstrate the need for writ relief to technical requirements for filing and how best to organize a petition.

The training will also detail what to expect procedurally after filing a writ petition, such as the different ways the appellate court can respond to a writ petition, potential timelines, availability of amicus support, and when to anticipate the opportunity to file further briefing.
